## **UfM Initiatives** | **UPFI**

- First Ministerial Conference of the UfM on Sustainable Urban Development held in Strasbourg on 10 November 2011 made a "call to donors to favour the emergence of sustainable urban development projects likely to be labelled by the UfM". Hence, **Urban Projects Finance Initiative (UPFI)**
- This initiative will constitute an umbrella under which there will be a group of urban development projects to be brought in time for approval to the Senior Officials.

## **UfM Initiatives | UPFI**





The Initiative aims at developing sustainable and innovative urban projects which serve as best practice examples and are potentially replicable.

It will accelerate the implementation of such urban projects and ensure their bankability according to the standards of the International Financial Institutions.

Its overarching goal is to help improve living conditions in the cities of the Mediterranean Partner Countries (MPCs), where urban growth is rapidly increasing due demographic and environmental pressure.

## **UPFI** | Partnership









The Initiative is managed by AFD and EIB in liaison with the EC and under the umbrella of the UfM Secretariat.


KFW and the CDC are closely associated.

## **UPFI** | Objectives

- Act as a pipeline for urban projects, to favor the emergence of sustainable urban development projects in 9 Southern and Eastern Mediterranean Countries
- > Select projects that are sustainable and innovative, serve as best practice examples and are potentially replicable
- Make them eligible vis-à-vis the standards of the donors and for UfM label
- The National Authorities will make the final decision on the project
- Give a boost to the implementation of the projects

- Ensure a balanced distribution throughout the region
- Have the approval by the concerned countries

## **UPFI** | **UPFI** Approach

- The UPFI approach:
  - Accelerates due diligence of the potential IFI financiers
  - Enables TA to finalize project preparation to international standards
  - May facilitate access to grant co-financing for investment or TA
  - Facilitates IFI coordination via Projects Committee
- Knowledge sharing events to share best-practices experiences
- Possible linkages: Medinas 2030, Smart cities, CMI

### **UPFI** | **UPFI** and **Smart** Cities

- Do the challenges in countries with an average or ICT access are linked to the governance efficiency?
- Are the ICT a possibility for increasing the interaction between the population and the local authorities in Southern and Eastern Mediterranean countries?
- What are the possibilities for increasing the interaction between public and private sectors in Smart City Projects?
- What role could UPFI have in developing Smart Cities in the Mediterranean Region?
- What could be the roadmap for the UfMS concerning Smart City projects and initiatives?

### **UPFI** | ICTs access

# High technology access cities: for example Capitals

- Identification of diversified Smart City projects.
- Setting-up of a network between urban stakeholders and private sector.

# Medium technology access cities: for example

- Meet the population needs to communicate with local authorities about governance, infrastructures, facilities needs.
- Possible leap-frogging of a development step regarding the public facilities and infrastructures in order to avoid some heavy administrative investments.

**Low** technology access cities: for example inland cities

- Establishment an integrated approach of the urban planning.
- Capacity building of the local authorities.
- First approach concerning ITC access needs.
